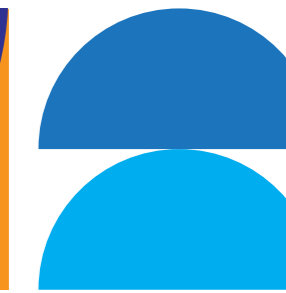
Over 10 weeks from July to September 2020, FORM Dance Projects embarked on a screen dance project actively engaging a group of 20 women over 65 from Western Sydney.

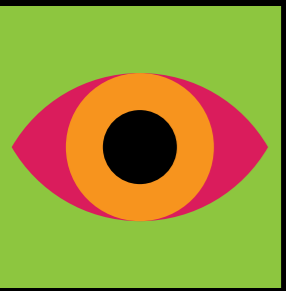

The work reflects on the agency of rivers by trying to dissolve the self within histories and futures of riverways.

Kalanjay is interested in exploring mythological and speculative technologies through sculpture, video and internet objects.
