Your child has been selected to represent Ambarvale High School in either the U13's or U15's West Leagues Cup Rugby League competition. This is a structured sporting contest, which involves teams from within the Greater West region. The sport is a tackling game and is well organised with student safety as our most important priority.

When: Tuesday, 2nd April 2019 - Week 10

Where: Eschol Park Sporting Complex, Epping Forest Drive, Eschol Park

Itinerary: Students will need to meet Ambarvale High School supervising teachers at the venue by 8:30am for roll call. Students will participate in 2-4 games across the day and may progress to round 2 which will be played on another day. Students will be dismissed from the venue at the completion of their games at approximately 2:00pm.

Parents are responsible for their child's transport and safety prior to 8:30am (start time) at the venue and following the completion of their last match at approximately 2:00pm.

Travel: Parents are responsible for their child's safety and transport to and from the venue. Limited spaces will be available to travel with teachers in their personal vehicles.

What to bring: Students are required to bring their own football equipment, including boots, mouth guard, drink bottle, hat, sunscreen and food for the day as there will be no canteen facilities.

Dress Code: Students are required to wear their full school uniform to and from the venue.

Compulsory Requirements: All students who wish to play on the day must partake in compulsory training sessions at Ambarvale High School prior to the game, to go through the code of conduct and compulsory safety requirements for contact sport. If they do not attend a training session, they are not eligible to play.
