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<b>Task Description: In-class test</b>  This is an open-book in-class test completed on OneNote. You can only write with a black pen (thickness 2 or 3) but you can use a highlighter. A reference sheet will be provided on the day as a hard copy. Only write in the box space provided under each question. If more space is required, please use the extra space at the end of the task.
