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#### **Task Description: Stages of foetal development and birthing options**

In this assessment, you must demonstrate your understanding of the stages of foetal development through each trimester of pregnancy and the options available to mothers when giving birth.

#### **PART A: Foetal Growth Timeline (Stages of Pregnancy)**

Create a visual timeline of the stages of foetal development until birth (the stages of pregnancy).

Your Foetal Growth Timeline should:

- Indicate each key growth stage (Progressions/stages = first trimester, second trimester, third trimester).
- Include an explanation on the foetal development in each stage.
- Include images to represent each stage.

#### **PART B: Birth Information Pack**

Create a birth information pack for a pregnant mother. Your information pack should be engaging, accurate and be easy to understand. Your information pack must include:

- A comparison of two settings / location for delivery.
- An explanation of one option for delivery AND the reason it may be selected.
- An explanation of one form of care / support available for mothers prior to / during birth.
- An outline of one form of pain management available to the mother during childbirth.

You may choose how you will create both your timeline and information pack: (e.g. Poster, Flyer, Booklet, Pamphlet, PowerPoint Presentation etc).

You will be assessed on your understanding of:

- the stages of foetal development through each trimester of pregnancy.
- the various options and supports available to mothers for their birth.
