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Task Description:	
The task is an open-book examination comprising 2 sections.

Section 2 comprising 4 short-response questions. Each question will cover one of the topics listed above.	
In particular, your:	
- Knowledge of compound angles in solving trigonometric equations.	
- Integration skills, including applying substitution methods.	
- Ability to find areas enclosed by curves, as well as volume of revolution, using integration.	
- Knowledge of differential equations, including slope fields.	
You are allowed to refer to hand-written notes only during the exam.

You are required to complete and submit the exam at the end of the allocated time.
