### **PROGRAM DETAILS**

WHEN: UPP weekly sessions run from April - August, 2020

**WHERE:** UOW campuses- Bega, Batemans Bay, Shoalhaven, Southern Highlands, Wollongong and South Western Sydney (Liverpool)

COST: Free for In2Uni sponsored school students or students who meet the eligibility requirements below

#### **PROGRAM BENEFITS**

During the program, you will have access to and receive the following:

- More than 20 hours of free tailored, group study and university preparation sessions with In2Uni Mentors and UOW staff
- A guaranteed Early Admissions interview or conditional offer to study at the University of Wollongong upon successful completion of the program
- Face to face and online study skills development
- **Mentoring** to explore post-high school options, including course options based on your Year 12 academic performance
- Assistance navigating higher education admission options and UAC online applications
- **Super Study Day** with tips and tricks around developing your interview skills and improving your HSC exam preparation
- Transition Day, to help you prepare for the transition from high school to higher education

#### WHO CAN APPLY?

Students **attending an In2Uni sponsored school** (list of schools can be found on the In2Uni website) who meet the below criteria are invited to apply to the Year 12 UPP:

- 1. You must be completing your HSC or IB in 2020 at an In2Uni high school
- 2. Your academic performance in Year 11 indicates that, at this time, you are unlikely to achieve the results you need to gain entry into your post-high school study or work goals

Students who are **not attending an In2Uni sponsored school** are invited to apply for the Year 12 UPP if they qualify under any of the following conditions:

- Identify as an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander
- Studies are being impacted by social disadvantage, disability or physical or mental health conditions\*
- Completing the HSC in a rural or remote area\*
- Currently experiencing financial hardship or disadvantage\*
- On a permanent humanitarian visa or have refugee status\*

\* You may be asked to provide details of these circumstances during the application process for the UPP. Please check with your school if you are unsure about whether you qualify under the rural or remote classification.

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

- 1. If you meet the eligibility requirements above, please complete the application form online at: **uow. info/yr12prep** before Sunday, 22 March 2020.
- 2. You will receive a notification email or phone call stating the outcome of your application by 24 April, 2020.
