## Educational Excursion Information and Consent Urban Dynamics Fieldwork

#### Dear Parent

Stage 6 Geography requires mandatory fieldwork to be undertaken throughout the course. The excursion to Barangaroo, Sydney meets the requirements for the successful completion of fieldwork in the topic of Urban Places. Students will be participating in a range of geographical exercises to understand the processes that continue to change urban places. This excursion will be held by the Observatory Hill Education Centre and surrounding areas and supervised by Ms Sinclair. This is an important part of the Year 12 Geography course and should be an enjoyable and rewarding experience for all involved.

When: Wednesday, 18 March 2020.

Where: Barangaroo and surrounding areas as detailed on itinerary.

#### Itinerary and transport:

- Meet at 7:30am at Campbelltown Train Station.
- Catch train from Campbelltown Train Station to Wynyard Train Station.
- Walk to Barangaroo Ferry Terminal, opposite Barangaroo House.
- Fieldwork begins at 9:20am.
- Students may have the opportunity to buy lunch or morning tea, however this cannot be guaranteed.
- Fieldwork finishes at 2:15pm.
- Walk to Wynyard Train Station to catch the 2:30pm service. Arrival at Campbelltown Train Station will be at approximately 3:45pm.
- Once back at Campbelltown Train Station students will be dismissed and be expected to find their own way
  home. Parents are responsible for their child's transport and safety prior to departure time at location and
  following return time at location.

Cost: \$9.00 plus students will need to pay for their public transport on the day. This will need to be done with an Opal Card, as paper tickets are no longer available for purchase. Opal cards can be purchased online at opal.com.au or from newsagents. Students cannot use their blue school Opal card they must have a green child/youth card. (Please have \$20.00 preloaded onto the Opal Card).
