As part of their studies, students will be participating in an excursion to the Australian War Memorial. During the excursion, students will undertake a program focusing on the conditions and nature of World War I, whilst also participating in an evaluative study of the various ways the past is commemorated.

When: Friday, 6 March 2020

Where: Australian War Memorial - Canberra

Itinerary and transport: Students will be travelling by bus. Students are required to make their own way to Ambarvale High School by 6:15am and will be dismissed from Ambarvale High School upon arrival at approximately 4:30pm.

Parents are responsible for their child's transport and safety prior to departure time at Ambarvale High School and following return time at Ambarvale High School.
