When: Friday, 26 March 2021
8.45am – 3pm

Where: Students will be at various locations.

Students referring the following sports will be travelling by **bus** from RMPS to the venue:

- Tag - Eschol Park Playing Fields
- Softball - Milton Park, Macquarie Fields
- Cricket - Jackson Park, Woodbine

Students referring the following sports will be **walking** from RMPS to the venue:

- Basketball - Snrs at Thomas Acres Reserve, Jnrs at Rosemeadow PS
- Teeball - Rosemeadow Playing Fields

Itinerary: All students are to go straight to RMPS, do NOT come to Ambarvale High School first. At the conclusion of the event, students will return to RMPS and are then required to make their own way home. Students will be travelling one of the following ways:

1. Students referring **Tag, Softball and Cricket**, will be travelling by **bus** to and from designated venues, with Rosemeadow Public School students and teachers.
2. Students referring **Basketball and Teeball**, will be **walking** to and from the designated venues, with Rosemeadow Public School students and teachers.

Buses and walkers depart the school at 9.00am. Students are to be at RMPS at 8.45am. Parents are responsible for their child's transport and safety prior to departure time at RMPS and following return time to RMPS.

What to bring: Students are required to bring a whistle to referee with, a bottle of water, a hat, recess and lunch. Hair should be tied back.


