As part of the Year 11 Biology course, your child is required to attend a field trip to Wooglemai Environmental Education Centre. Wooglemai Environmental Education Centre provides quality educational experiences for students in an outdoor setting. Ambarvale High School has been using these facilities as part of the Biology course for a number of years.

Students will participate in a variety of activities that help to achieve the outcomes required for the compulsory 'Depth Study' component of the Preliminary HSC Biology course.

When: Tuesday, 16 March 2021 – Wednesday, 17 March 2021 (Week 8).

Where: Wooglemai Environmental Education Centre, Sheehys Creek Road, Oakdale.

Itinerary and transport:

- Students are to meet Miss Kilcoyne at the Science staffroom at 8:40am.
- Students will depart from Ambarvale High School at approximately 9:00am and will catch a bus to Wooglemai Environmental Education Centre.
- Students will spend Thursday night at the Wooglemai Environmental Education Centre, under teacher supervision.
- Students will return to Ambarvale High School at approximately 2:50pm on Wednesday, 17 March 2021.

Cost: \$75.00. All monies must be paid to the office by Wednesday, 10 March 2021 or online via the Ambarvale High School website (<https://ambarvale-h.schools.nsw.gov.au/>). Receipt or record of payment must be attached to the permission note and returned to the Science staffroom.

GEAR CHECKLIST FOR OVERNIGHT CAMP AT WOOGLEMAI

- ❖ Any medication and instructions for use (e.g. Asthma relief spray/Epipen)
- ❖ Sleeping bag (and perhaps also a blanket in cold weather)
- ❖ Pillowcase – (each bed has one pillow)
- ❖ Towel and Toiletries – soap, toothbrush and toothpaste, deodorant, etc
- ❖ Clothes for bushwalking
- ❖ Sturdy walking shoes
- ❖ Enough clothes and underwear for 2 (or 3 OR 4) day camp
Make sure clothing is suitable for activities –
Short shorts or skirts are **NOT** appropriate for High Ropes Course
- ❖ Tracksuit or pyjamas for sleeping
- ❖ Hat, sunscreen and insect repellent
- ❖ If Kayaking bring swimmers, extra towel, thongs or swim shoes are excellent
- ❖ Raincoat and warm jacket (if weather looks bad)
- ❖ Tea towel, plate, bowl, mug, knife, fork and spoon - **NOT** DISPOSABLE PRODUCTS
(or you may use the Wooglemai ones)
- ❖ Garbage bag for dirty or wet clothing
- ❖ Camera (optional)
- ❖ Torch
- ❖ Money for souvenirs (optional) in a labelled envelope
- ❖ **DO NOT** bring any electronic games, etc to camp

Please make sure that all items are clearly labelled with student's name and school.
