

LATE TO SCHOOL

- Students who are late to school miss valuable learning time.
- Students need to **arrive at school on time** each day (through the gates by 8:30am).
- If students are **late to school they need a note** from a parent explaining why they are late.
- If students have a signed parental note, there are no consequences (unless there is a pattern of absence, in which case we will contact you).
- Students who are late to school **without a** note will receive a **consequence**:
 - 1. The **first** time late, no note = **warning**
 - 2. The **second** time late, no note = **lunch time detention**
 - 3. The third time late, no note = after school detention

Please support us by ensuring your child is at school on time or has a signed parental note on the rare occasion they are late.

If your child is late to school without your knowledge and hence without a note, we would encourage you not to give retrospective permission.
