When: Thursday, 27 February 2020 - Friday, 28 February 2020 (Week 5).

Where: Wooglemai Environmental Education Centre, Sheehys Creek Road, Oakdale.

Itinerary and transport:

- Students are to meet Miss Irvine and Miss Xian at the Science staffroom at 8:20am.
- Students will depart from Ambarvale High School at approximately 9:00am and will catch a bus to Wooglemai Environmental Education Centre.
- Students will spend Thursday night at the Wooglemai Environmental Education Centre, under teacher supervision.
- Students will return to Ambarvale High School at approximately 2:50pm on Friday, 28 February 2020.

Cost: \$75.00. All monies must be paid to the office by Thursday, 20 February 2020 or online via the Ambarvale High School website (https://ambarvale-h.schools.nsw.gov.au/). Receipt or record of payment must be attached to the permission note and returned to the Science staffroom.
