Your child has been selected to represent Ambarvale High School in the Opens School Boy Trophy, Rugby League competition. This is a structured sporting contest, which involves teams from within the Greater West region. The Schoolboy Trophy is made up of a round robin gala day, with the top 2 teams from the day progressing onto the Western Sydney Schoolboy Trophy finals. The sport is a tackling game and is well organised with student safety as our most important priority.

**When:** Wednesday, 3rd April 2019 - Week 10

**Where:** Oswald Reserve, 26 Oswald Cres, St Helens Park NSW 2560

**Itinerary:** Students will need to meet Ambarvale High School supervising teachers **at the venue by 8:30am** for roll call. Students will participate in 2-4 games across the day and may progress to round 2 which will be played on another day. Students will be dismissed from the venue at the completion of their games at approximately 2:00pm.

Parents are responsible for their child's transport and safety prior to 8:30am (start time) at the venue and following the completion of their last match at approximately 2:00pm.

**Travel:** Parents are responsible for their child's safety and transport to and from the venue. Limited spaces will be available to travel with teachers in their personal vehicles.

**What to bring:** Students are required to bring their own football equipment, including boots, mouth guard, drink bottle, hat, sunscreen and food for the day as there will be no canteen facilities.

**Dress Code:** Students are required to wear their **full school uniform** to and from the venue.
