Educational Excursion Information and Consent Western Sydney University Chemistry Day

Dear Parent

Lachlan Macquarie College in partnership with Western Sydney University (Parramatta Campus) has organised a half day of activities for your child to attend.

This day is aimed at students fulfilling mandatory first-hand investigations from the Year 12 (HSC) Chemistry course that cannot be completed in the school laboratory effectively.

The students will be participating in the following two activities:

- 1) Atomic Absorption Spectroscopy and Ultraviolet Visible Spectrophotometry
(Syllabus outcomes: 8.1.4)
- 2) Sulfate Experiment
(Syllabus outcomes: 8.1.2 and 8.1.3)

When: Wednesday, 19 June 2019

Where: Western Sydney University, Parramatta - South Campus

Itinerary and transport: Students to meet the organising teacher at Campbelltown Train Station at 7:45am to catch the 8:03am train to Rydalmere. Students will catch the 12:22pm train back and will arrive at 1:27pm at Campbelltown Station where students will be dismissed from the station on arrival. Students will need to pay their train fare on the day and must have their own Opal card to do this. Students **cannot** use their blue school Opal card they must have a green child/youth card. Students should load their card with approximately \$10.00 for their travel.

Cost: \$15.00. All monies must be paid to the Office by Friday 14 June 2019 (**no exceptions**). Payments can also be made online via our website. Receipt must be sighted by Mrs Xian.

What to bring: Pen, paper, recess and lunch (food outlets will be available).
