LEARNING NEEDS

Our students have access to a wonderful range of resources to support student learning and maximise results. Through the use of technology such as interactive whiteboards and connected classrooms we have the opportunity to use video conferencing to engage students and to share or gain information from anywhere in the world. Ambarvale High School has highly experienced Learning and Support Teachers on staff that enable us to cater for students with specific needs. Students have the opportunity to participate in enrichment and acceleration programs, including Extension English and Mathematics in Years 9 and 10. Senior students are linked to a variety of university courses through Wollongong University and the University of Technology. We achieve outstanding performance in the HSC with 70% of our students receiving first round offers for their first preference in university courses. Recent ATARS have remained consistently high, 2012 — 98.6, 2013 — 94.5, 2014 — 96.7, 2015 — 97.2, 2016 — 87.75 and with three distinguished achievers in 2017.
